About Sunday Streets Houston

Can bars and restaurants participate? Can they create or extend their patios? Yes, all businesses can participate and are encouraged to open during the event and/or provide temporary outdoor space/seating on their private property or within parking lots. Routine permits are required for outdoor activities (health permits, TABC permits, etc.).

What type of vendors and activations are permitted? We encourage all vendor types – cultural food, merchandise, art/crafts, entertainment. For example, karaoke, selling jewelry/clothes, interactive games/activities (ping pong, badminton, yoga, tai chi, etc.).

Will the City of Houston set up stages for music or programs? No, the City of Houston is opening the streets to provide a place for people to be physically active. We encourage participants to enjoy the entertainment or services provided by businesses and organizations along the routes on private property.

Are there fees or permits? There are no fees to participate, but all food and beverage vendors must abide by regular City policies and regulations.

Is Sunday Streets Houston a street festival? No, Sunday Streets Houston is not a street festival – this event is a family-friendly opportunity to be physically active and to see different parts of Houston that would not otherwise be experienced.
